Following are a few facts regarding VSIFF 2011, where the Local Selection films came in from etc for your interest.

Submissions

The Very Short International Film Festival has two Selection Processes and Sections; The International Selection and the Local Selection.

The **International Selection** is processed, selected and judged in Paris by the parent organization of VSIFF, **Festival international des Très Courts [Trés Courts]** managed by **Nanosphere Productions**. It is this Selection that will be viewed around the world in up to 20 countries, 80 cities all at the same time, 4-13th May 2012. In 2011, 46 films were shown in the International Selection.

The **Local Selection** is processed, selected and judged in Singapore by **Very Short International Film Festival [VSIFF]** managed by **ZoMedia Pty Ltd**. The Chief Judge will be **Eric Khoo**. This Selection will be shown in Singapore alongside the International Selection during the Festival screenings 11, 12 and 13th May 2012. In 2011, 26 films were shown in the Local Selection.

For a film to be considered for the **International Selection** please send the film on a DVD along with a completed and signed registration form to ZoMedia. **This must all reach ZoMedia no later than the 10th February 2012.** These films will also be considered for the Local Selection.

For a film to be considered for the **Local Selection** only, please send the film on a DVD along with a completed and signed registration form to ZoMedia. **This must all reach ZoMedia no later than the 29th February 2012.**
